



Southerndown Riding Club – Team Commitment

Each riding club throughout Britain belongs to an Area. We are part of Area 15. When we hold an area competition, in whatever discipline, all the other riding clubs within Area 15 have the opportunity to compete against each other. Depending on the competition rules the winners then compete nationally in a championship.

There are some commitments you'll need to fulfil when you enter an Area Qualifier.

1. Your horse will need to be up to date with the FLU vaccine. There is a [flu vac checking tool attached here](#). Please also show your horse's passport to Janneke before you enter to make sure your flu vaccine card is correct and right up to date.
2. You will need to take your passport and your vaccination card (if separate) with you to the qualifier. These need to be declared before you compete. The British Riding Club rules are strictly abided by at Area Qualifiers and National Championships and you will not be allowed to compete if there are any errors or if you forget your passport.
3. All qualifiers need to be paid for in advance. However SRC will refund a portion of your entry if you go to the qualifier.
4. Before you enter, make yourself familiar with the date of the championships. You may not feel you have a chance of qualifying but you may get a shock on the day. We have had a lot of surprises in the past!
5. You will be expected to be available for the championship dates if you enter the qualifier. This is particularly important if you are entered in a team as it would be devastating for the other team members should you have to let them down.
6. If you or your horse have BSJA winnings, either jointly or separately, you will need to check with Janneke whether or not this prevents your entry into a Riding Club Area Qualifier.
7. Be prepared to have a lot of fun!
