## SHOW JUMPING CLASSES

**Combined Training Entrants: (classes 2,3 & 5) who also wish to take part in the Show jumping classes 6 – 8 Pay an extra £4.00 and their CT. round counts as 1<sup>st</sup> round. Clear rounds to go forward to a jump off against the clock. This must be the same height class . Run as two phase.**

**Entries to the show jumping classes 5 & 6 will be limited & taken on a first come first served basis.** No entry will be accepted without the correct fee enclosed.

In the event of cancellation due to adverse weather conditions, **refunds will be issued within 6 weeks of competition, to written applications received within 7 days of the event.** An administration fee will be withheld from these.

Hard Hats to current standard as in BRC Rule book 2017 with BRC TAG ATTACHED. Must be worn at all times when mounted –Correct Dress please. Juniors must wear back protectors to the required standard as in BRC Rule book 2016 during show-jumping phase. Seniors are strongly advised to do the same.

The Judges decision is final.

Any objection must be lodged with the secretary within 5 minutes of the end of the class concerned together with a deposit of £20.00 returnable if the objection is sustained.

The Committee reserves the right to refuse entry to any class without explanation except to the appropriate body.

The Committee cannot be held responsible for any error in the time schedule and reserve the right and cancel or amend in any way.

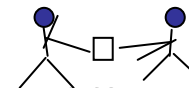
